

VIRGINIA GENERAL ASSEMBLY - 2015

The 2015 Virginia General Assembly came into session on January 14 and is scheduled to close on February 28. A number of significant issues will face legislators during this time. Tops among them will be ethics reform. With the trial and conviction of former Governor McDonnell, members will consider placing limits on gifts to elected officials and how those gifts are reported. The state budget will also be getting attention. With a looming \$322 million deficit, members will have to make cuts and spending adjustments that will be controversial.


On the water well industry front, we have already seen the introduction of a mandatory connection bill for Montgomery County. Similar legislation was unsuccessful last year and the VWWA will be working to defeat this ill conceived effort. There is legislation to create a comprehensive study of the Eastern Virginia Groundwater Management area and what the policy should be regarding withdrawal permits for industry as well as for private wells in that region. VWWA will be closely monitoring this issue.

Another issue getting attention this session will be the land application of industrial waste and biosolids and the potential effect on groundwater. Interested parties include VWWA, agricultural, industrial and the environmental community.
